

CANYON CREST ACADEMY SHUTTLES 2009-10

The decision to attend Canyon Crest Academy should not be based on the availability of district transportation. In order to meet our ever-changing program needs and the shifting student population, the District will continue to phase out the CCA shuttles. No bus passes will be issued to new students, unless their sibling had a bus pass in 06/07. This will continue for the following year and the CCA shuttle operation will end no later than June 2010, or at a date to be established by the School Board.

Every year the Transportation Department faces the challenge of maximizing the use of our limited resources to meet the needs of our district. To help maximize the use of our limited resources, the district, in the 1980's eliminated home to school transportation at the high school level.

The CCA shuttles were started in the 04/05 school year as a way to attract students to a new school that consisted of temporary trailers in a parking lot. In the early years of CCA, permanent road and freeway improvements were under construction and access to the school was not convenient. All construction is now completed. It was never the intent of the District to make the shuttles permanent after the completion of the school and roads.

The District does not have the resources to continue providing this level of transportation service to CCA without jeopardizing service to other schools. In order to be consistent with our high school transportation policy and to utilize our limited transportation resources at the middle schools for home to school transportation, the phasing out of the CCA shuttles will conclude this school year 2009-2010.
