vision of education and a message of urgency calling on the entire community to make the necessary difference for our students who face a new and surprising world compared to past decades.

Instead of the USSR, their biggest economic competitor will be China, which is turning out about 20 million English speakers a year and where there are currently 176.7 million school children and adults studying English. Soon there will be more English speakers in China than in the United States.

The State of California continues to face tough economic conditions that will challenge all who strive to educate the State's next generation.

## x5661 : The New Classified Job Line

Classified employees now have their own job hotline. Contact (760) 753-6491, extension 5661 to hear a list of all current job openings and their application deadlines.

The job line is updated as the information changes.

This is part of a new approach to internal recruiting that will include job postings on the HR website as well.

In exchange for this simple access by phone and computer, employees will no longer be plagued with sheets of paper cluttering the inbox with job postings. Each flyer consumes a ream of paper, so the job line is also part of the effort to "go green." To recap, employees now have **FIVE** simple-to-access sources for

information about new job openings and application deadlines:

1. *The New Job Line*
2. *The traditional posting* on the bulletin board at each site and in the Classified Personnel Office.
3. *The job interest form* in the Classified Personnel Office to request that a notice be mailed directly to you at work or at home.
4. *Your phone call* to the Classified Personnel Office (x5515 Donna Crosby).
5. Finally, *soon to appear on the website* : all transfer notices and all promotional recruitment opportunities.
