CERTIFICATED PERSONNEL

PROBATIONARY/PERMANENT STATUS

Permanent status is granted by law to teachers who have satisfactorily passed a period of probationary service. Permanent personnel may continue in teaching positions if they keep their teaching certificate in force or are not dismissed for reasons specified in the state school law

PERMANENT STATUS

A probationary teacher who has been employed by the district in a position or positions requiring certification for two complete consecutive school years and is then rehired for the next succeeding school year shall become a permanent employee at the beginning of the third year. (Education Code 44929.21)

Permanent status applies only to teachers holding regular certificates.
