

RECRUITING NEW BOARD MEMBERS

In an attempt to assure the school district will be able to secure Board Members from the widest possible number of interested, active, well-informed citizens, the Board directs the Superintendent and/or the Board secretary to:

1. Publicize widely all public Board meetings, committee openings, and community related activities of the schools.
2. Publicize the annual school election well in advance so that prospective Board Members will have time to investigate the responsibilities of the position carefully, and fulfill the requirements of the law in presenting nominating petitions.
3. Solicit the advice and cooperation of parents, the professional and business community, and any other groups seriously concerned for the quality of our schools.
