THE DISTRICT

The award-winning San Dieguito Union High School District is one of the nation's finest districts, offering a wealth of academic and extracurricular opportunities in which its students can engage and excel. The SDUHSD educates students from the coastal North San Diego County communities of Cardiff-by-the-Sea, Encinitas, Leucadia, and Olivenhain in the City of Encinitas; the cities of Del Mar and Solana Beach; the community of La Costa in the City of Carlsbad; the community of Carmel Valley in the City of San Diego; and the communities of Rancho Santa Fe and Fairbanks Ranch.

Located in the North Coastal area of San Diego County, the highly regarded school district of approximately 13,000 students has ten schools, which include four middle schools, two traditional comprehensive high schools, two comprehensive high schools of choice, and two alternative high schools. It also has an adult education program. Students come from five excellent elementary districts: Cardiff, Del Mar, Encinitas, Rancho Santa Fe, and Solana Beach.
