


Illuminate: Reports on Assessments-The very basics

Open the assessment for which you'd like to see reports. You'll immediately see information about how students performed.

Quite a bit of data populates automatically for you, including overall performance on the assessment, performance by standard, your lowest performing questions, and performance by student subgroup.

Often, in Illuminate, when you click on a number, or part of a graph, it'll take you out to a list of students. In this case, if you click the number 15 by the green section, you'll see the names of the kids who scored "proficient"

To see more data, like how kids answered each question, click the **"Reports"** tab.

This report shows the students by ID and by name, the number of questions they got correct, the total # of questions, and their scores as a percentage. Performance bands default to match CSTs, and you can change those if desired.

Name of Report: Performance Summary Report

This shows you how kids did overall, by performance band, and overall by standard, for all kids who took the test (your students, and anyone with whom you shared the assessment. You have to scroll down a bit to see this particular grid.)

FOR PLCs: This is data analysis levels 2 and 3—for which you need results BY ELO, for all of YOUR students (Level 2) and by ELO for all students with ALL TEACHERS.

You'll notice in this sample that the results are the same fro "district," "school" and teacher, meaning that this teacher gave this test to her class only,

Student Small Slips:

This is a small slip of paper that you can print out for each student. You can choose whether to show the correct answer, or performance on each standard. In this case, we're looking at the correct answer in the column with a check mark, and then the student's response in the column marked "you".
