



What Will The Learning Model Be In 2021-2022?

In alignment with State of California guidelines for all students in grades 7-12, the base education model for the 2021-2022 school year will be in-person, full time, at school learning and instruction.

What Is The Daily Schedule?

All schools will operate under their regular middle & high school bell schedules, while meeting required daily instructional minutes, five days per week.



What Will Classrooms Look Like?

Instruction will return to regular daily instruction and assessment opportunities, for the full class period. Attendance, grading and discipline policies will be followed and students shall engage respectfully, safely, and with academic integrity at all times. Teachers will take regular attendance during each class period.

What Classes Will Be Offered?

School-specific master schedules for the 2021-2022 school year are being developed based on student course selections made in Spring 2021. SDUHSD schools analyze student course selections and data across the district to determine in-person course offering. This includes academic intervention offerings to address any learning needs.



Transition To In-Person Learning & Student Supports

Students will be supported with the transition to in-person learning, focusing on creating safe, welcoming, inclusive schools and classrooms, while mindfully shifting students back into the school routine and building resilience and healthy coping strategies.
