

## The CA Dashboard:

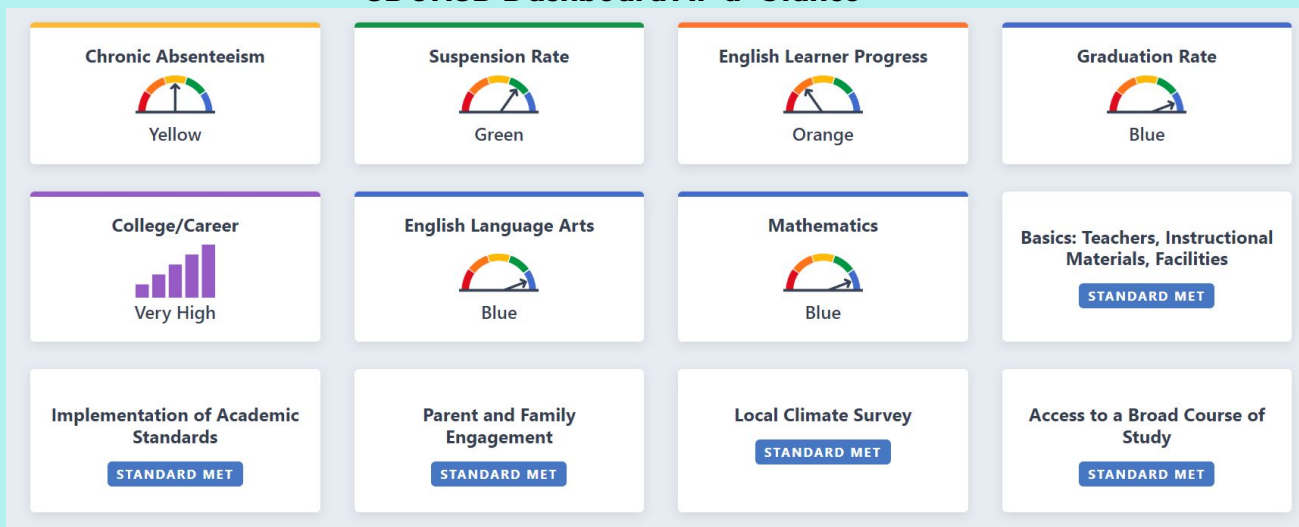
- Is **our state's public school accountability system** that addresses the requirements in the federal Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) and reflects the priorities of California's Local Control Funding Formula (LCFF)
- Includes **multiple State and Local indicators** that measure student performance and progress
- Includes reports that are used at the school and district level for **high level evaluation** of student programs and supports
- Provides educators with a more detailed picture of strengths as well as areas of opportunity for improvement

## How the Dashboard Works:



- The 2023 Dashboard is a full **restart of California's accountability system** and once again includes 5 **performance colors**
- Performance colors on the state indicators are determined based on a combination of **status** (current year performance) and **change** (current year performance compared with prior year performance)
- The Dashboard has a **different appearance from the past 2 years** and no longer includes status bars.

## The 8 State Priorities and the Dashboard Indicators

Each of the state 8 priorities are aligned with an indicator on the California School Dashboard.

Three main categories:  
**Conditions of Learning (Access to Learning)**  
**Engagement (School Climate & Culture)**  
**Student Outcomes (Academics)**

Priority 5: Student Engagement	State: Chronic Absenteeism & Graduation Rate
Priority 6: School Climate	State: Suspension Rate Local: Local Climate Survey
Priority 7: Access to a Broad Course of Study	State: College/Career Local: Access to a Broad Course of Study
Priority 8: Other Student Outcomes	State: College/Career
