


It has come to our attention that the Scenario 8 map posted on our website was a duplice of Scenario 7. The variance data was correct. The picture of the map was not. To help clarify what happened, below is the series of events.


- At our January 20, 2022 Board meeting, in our original posting of the first three demographer maps (Maps 1, 2, and 3), there was a bold purple line indicating the current trustee areas, as well as a red star, indicating each of the trustees and their term date.
- On February 4, 2022, alternative maps (including Scenario 1C, Scenario 7, and the correct Scenario 8) were posted to our website; however, they did not have the bold purple lines or the red star.
- After all of the maps were completed by the Demographer, at the District's request, the Demographer added the bold purple lines and red star to be consistent with the original three maps.
- On February 9, 2022, the District then reposted all of the maps from the Demographer with the bold purple lines and red star included. Those maps were 1A, 1B, 1C, 1D, 2A, 3A, 6, 7 and 8.
- We have since noticed that the maps sent from the Demographer, with the addition of the bold purple lines and red star, had an error. The Scenario 8 map was a duplicate of Scenario 7. The variance data was correct. The picture of the map was not.
- At the board meeting on February 10, 2022, the Board narrowed the alternate map options to three final maps: Scenario 7, Scenario 8, and Scenario 1C; however, scenarios 7 and 8 were duplicate maps. The variance data supporting the maps is accurate.
