Safe Reopening Plan – Health, Safety and Operations Protocols

In order to mitigate the spread of COVID-19, all students, staff, and members of the public on campuses are subject to the below protocols. All protocols are consistent with the Safe Reopening Plan and the California Department of Public Health Guidelines.



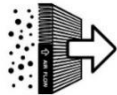
Personal Protective Equipment

- All staff and students are required to wear a mask following guidelines



Cleaning and Sanitation

- Classrooms and campuses cleaned and disinfected daily, handwashing stations, hand sanitizer and disinfectant wipes in all classrooms



Air Filtration and Fresh Air

- Classrooms equipped with MERV 8+ filters, which can achieve up to MERV 11 efficiencies; filters replaced more frequently than recommended, HEPA filters in all classrooms, fresh air from windows and doors as available, outdoor classroom spaces, outdoor pop-up shelters



Physical Spacing

- Maintaining six feet as practical, teacher work station six feet from students, minimum of one meter between desks in classrooms, traffic flow patterns on campus with spacing markers



Daily Health Screenings

- All staff will be screened daily, all students will be screened daily at home and are subject to additional screening on campus, online application for tracking



COVID-19 Testing

- All employees tested following San Diego County Public Health Order, student and additional staff testing available through an agreement with UC San Diego



COVID-19 Reporting Dashboard

- Localized Positive COVID-19 Dashboard for all schools

- All plans and protocols reviewed by medical, infectious disease, and epidemiological professionals: San Diego County Public Health, Rady Children's Hospital, UC San Diego
