San Dieguito Union High School District Community,

In consultation with San Diego Health and Human Services Agency, San Dieguito Union High School District has ordered all schools to close in order to curb the potential transmission of the coronavirus (COVID-19). Schools will be closed and children should stay home. We will remain in close contact with the San Diego County Office of Education and local public health officials throughout the duration of this closure and will provide updates to families as appropriate. The school closure will be through at least March 27, 2020, unless conditions call for an extension. All extracurricular activities are canceled while schools are closed.

The District is in the process of determining what options we will provide for our students to continue learning while our schools are closed. No instruction will take place next week as we want our staff and families making plans for their health and safety. We will provide further information next week about how learning will continue.

During the week of March 16 through 23, campuses will not be accessible for students with the exception that to support our students in the community, we will have nutritional services available at Earl Warren Middle School and San Dieguito High School Academy, which will include both breakfast and lunch.
