2021-2022 INDEPENDENT STUDY - HIGH SCHOOL

SDUHSD will offer Independent Study only to students who reside within district boundaries for whom in-person instruction would present a health risk to the student or family, as determined by the parent or guardian, per AB 130. This Independent Study option is approved for the 2021-2022 school year only.



INDEPENDENT STUDY WILL INCLUDE:

- Opportunities for parent/student/educator conferences to explain program and expectations
- Schedules, curriculum, and course pacing aligned with the high school semester or 4 x 4 schedule
- Weekly synchronous instruction and independent learning.
- Students may have opportunities for face-to-face interactions when possible (i.e. small group intervention, in-person tutoring, or other support opportunities)
- Students are able to transition back to in-person instruction during the school year
- The program may not be appropriate for all students - parents must agree to be educational partners in this learning option
