Parent Overview - All Information below will be sent electronically prior to pre-enrollment on January, 17, 2023

<p>When does pre-enrollment start? (Pre-enrollment means enrolling in our district.)</p>	<p>The online pre-enrollment window for incoming 7th grade students will open January 17, 2023. Visit the ENROLLMENT link on the district website, sduhsd.net to begin the enrollment process.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Complete the initial enrollment for your boundary school via Aeries Online Pre-Enrollment Platform at your earliest convenience. You will be sent a link via email January 17, 2023. • You will be prompted to upload required documentation (included in packet), which can also be found on sduhsd.net under enrollment.
<p>When is the last day to submit online enrollment?</p>	<p>February 10, 2023. Failure to submit online enrollment by this deadline will delay the enrollment process and online course selection.</p>
<p>How do I find out which middle school is my designated boundary school?</p>	<p>Based on your current residence address. Please visit sduhsd.net, click on the enrollment button, School Location and Boundaries Map. Please note, your student's designated boundary middle school is based on where you reside, not which elementary school your student currently attends.</p>
<p>I reside in the district boundary but want to enroll in a middle school outside my designated boundary school?</p>	<p>Please complete the pre-enrollment process at your boundary school prior to filling out an intradistrict transfer online application. To access the online application and for more information go to sduhsd.net, click on Parent and Student, Intradistrict Transfer. The Intra-District Transfer applications will be accepted February 13, 2023 - February 27, 2023.</p>
<p>What is Aeries?</p>	<p>Aeries is our student information system. It consists of two different platforms: The Aeries Online Enrollment Platform is used by parents to submit the initial pre-enrollment, even if you have a current parent portal account. Once pre-enrollment has been processed by the boundary school, a parent portal account is automatically created in the Aeries Parent and Student Portal Platform. This software application will be used by parents and students as a tool to view grades, attendance, classes, assignments, and contact throughout grades 7-12.</p>

<p>What immunizations are required to attend SDUHSD?</p>	<p>SDUHSD adheres to the California Department of Public Health (CDPH) Immunization requirements. All students are required to have vaccinations fully completed/up to date before the start of school. Students must present their immunization records when enrolling in the district. In addition to the required immunizations for enrollment, students entering 7th-12th grade for the first time will also need: Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis (Tdap) —1 dose, Varicella — 2 doses (SDUHSD Board Policy 5141.31)</p>
<p>Where can I find information about middle school information nights? Carmel Valley Middle School Diegueno Middle School Earl Warren Middle School Oak Crest Middle School Pacific Trails Middle School</p>	<p>Each middle school will have an opportunity available for parents and students to learn more about their school and receive course selection information. Please participate at your designated SDUHSD boundary school, even if you intend to request to transfer to another school. You will be provided with information about course selection, elective courses, school bell schedule, math diagnostic placement tests, academic support services, clubs, sports, and parent portal information and most of this information is the same for each of our middle schools. For dates and details, please visit your boundary middle school's website.</p>

<p>When do we select courses?</p>	<p>School counselors assist students and families with academic, social-emotional, and college and career support throughout grades 7-12. Course selection will take place March 13-20, 2023. Families will be provided course selection information from the school they will be attending in the Fall. Please visit the SDUHSD course of study webpage to learn more courses offered at our middle schools.</p>
<p>Where can I learn more about math course enrollment options?</p>	<p>Separate communication will be sent detailing information about next course enrolment options for math. Information about SDUHSD Mathematics can be located on our district course of study webpage.</p>
<p>What happens if I can't complete online enrollment?</p>	<p>Contact your boundary school to receive a paper pre-enrollment packet. They will be available when the window opens on January 17, 2023.</p>
<p>Who verifies all pre-enrollment information?</p>	<p>SDUHSD staff will finalize your enrollment based on your online entries and verification of submitted documentation. Your enrollment will not be processed unless all required documents are received. SDUHSD staff will contact you directly.</p>
