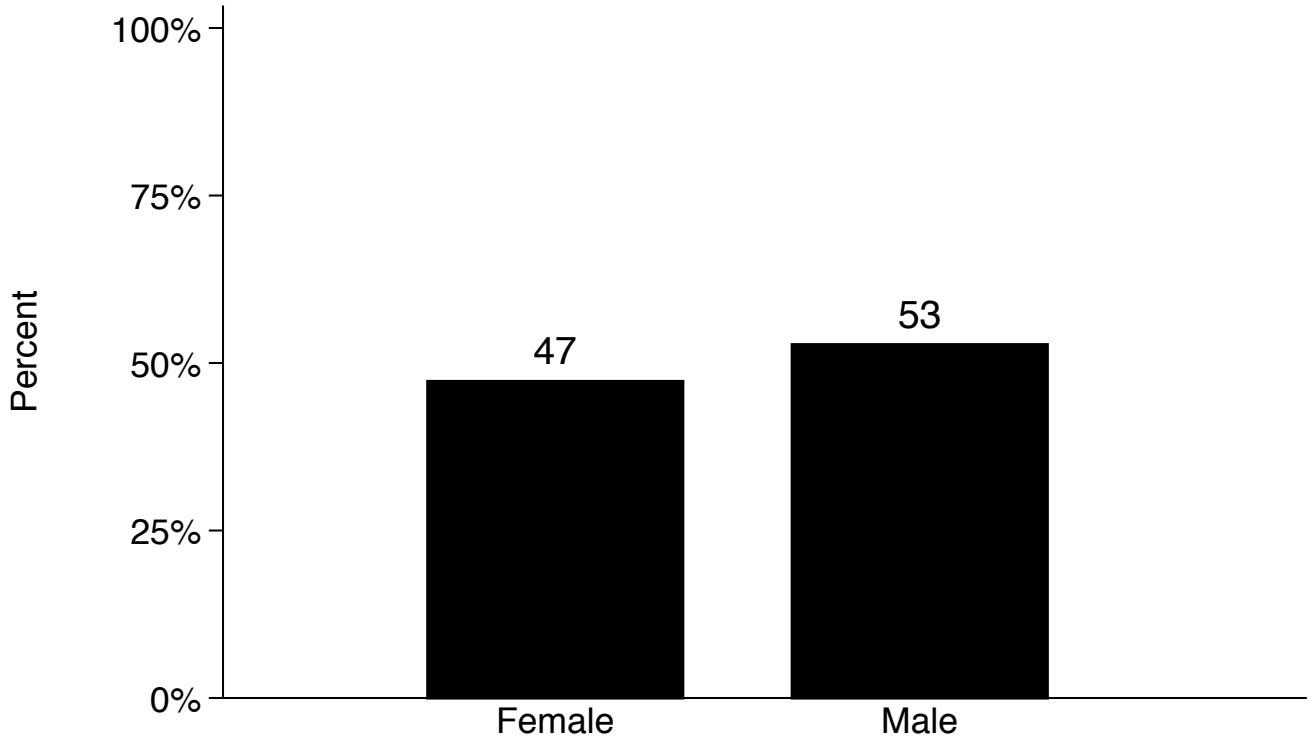

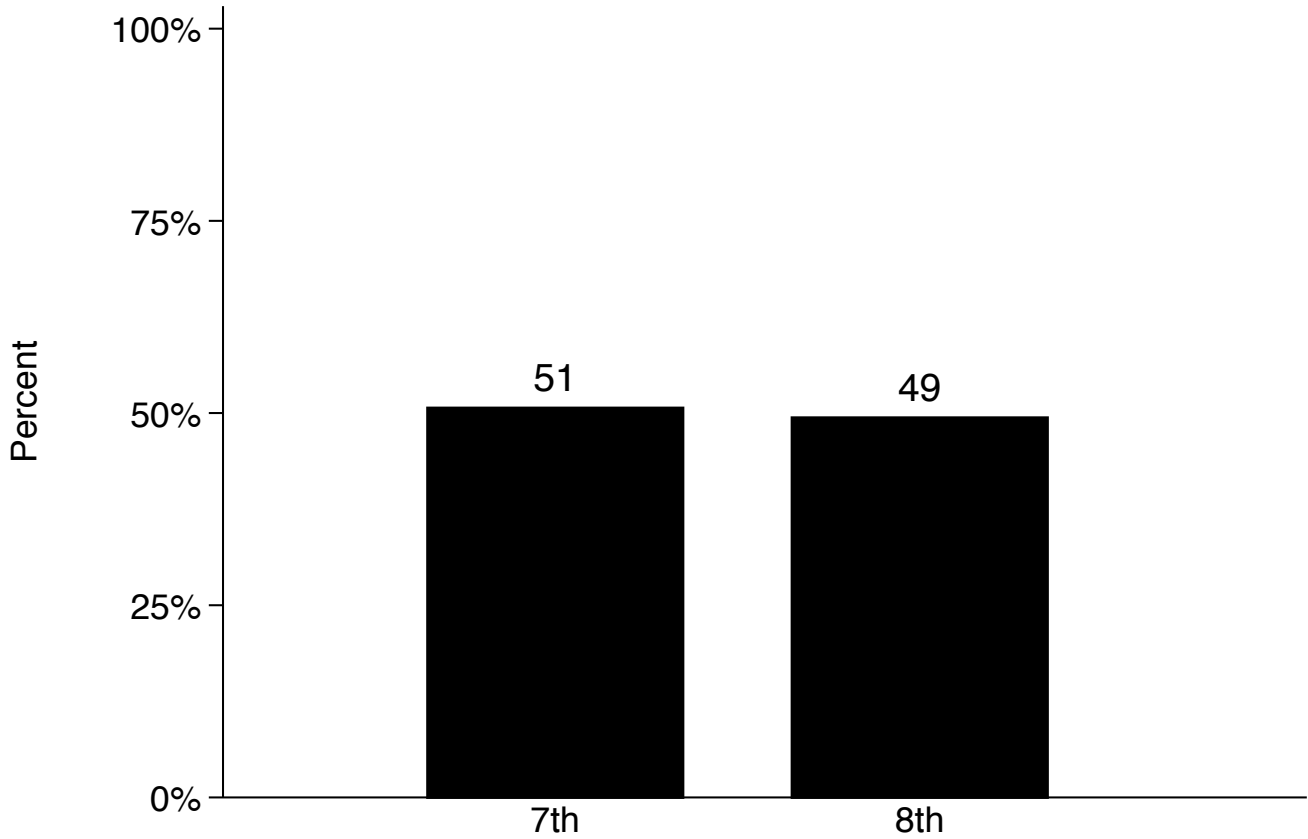
Gender Distribution

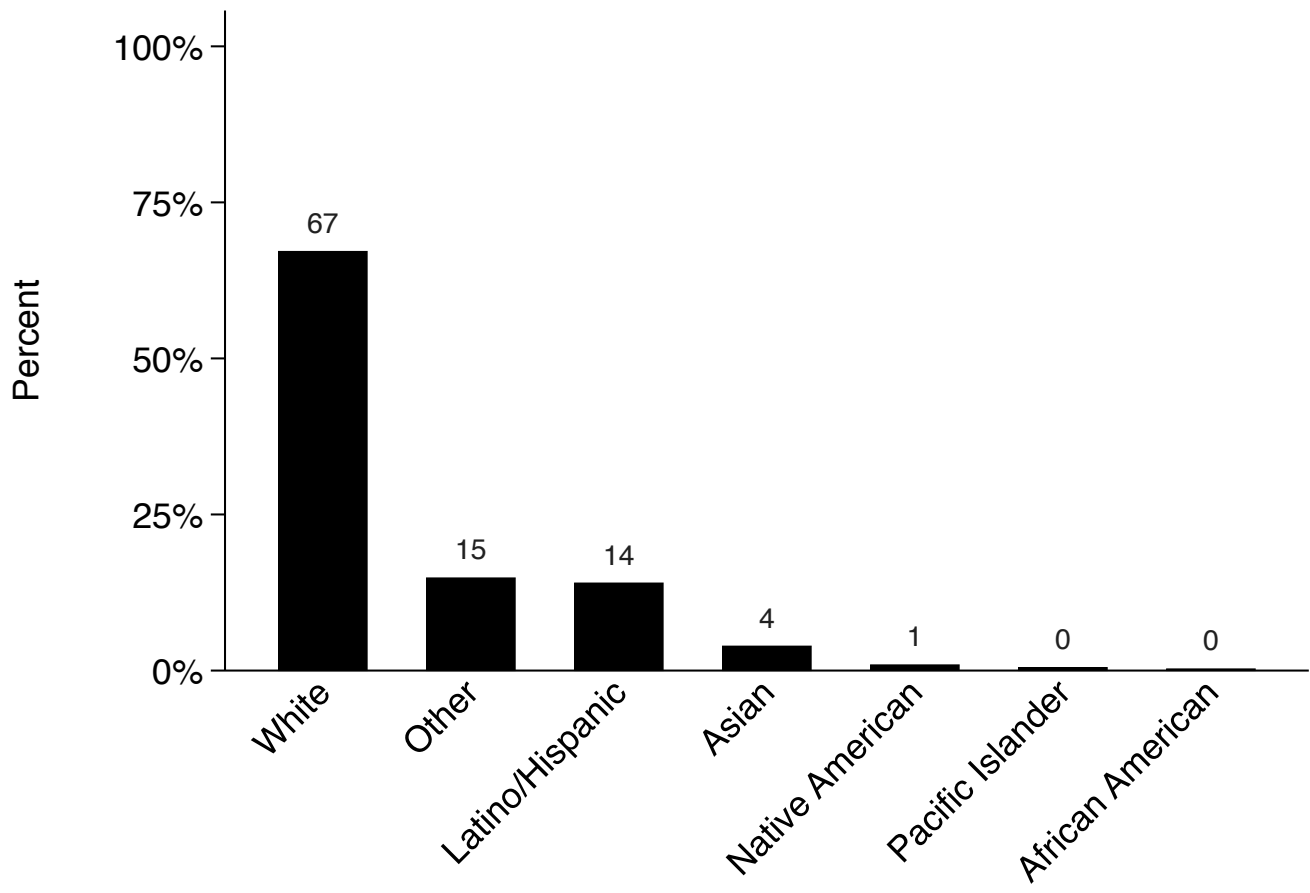
Grade Level Distribution

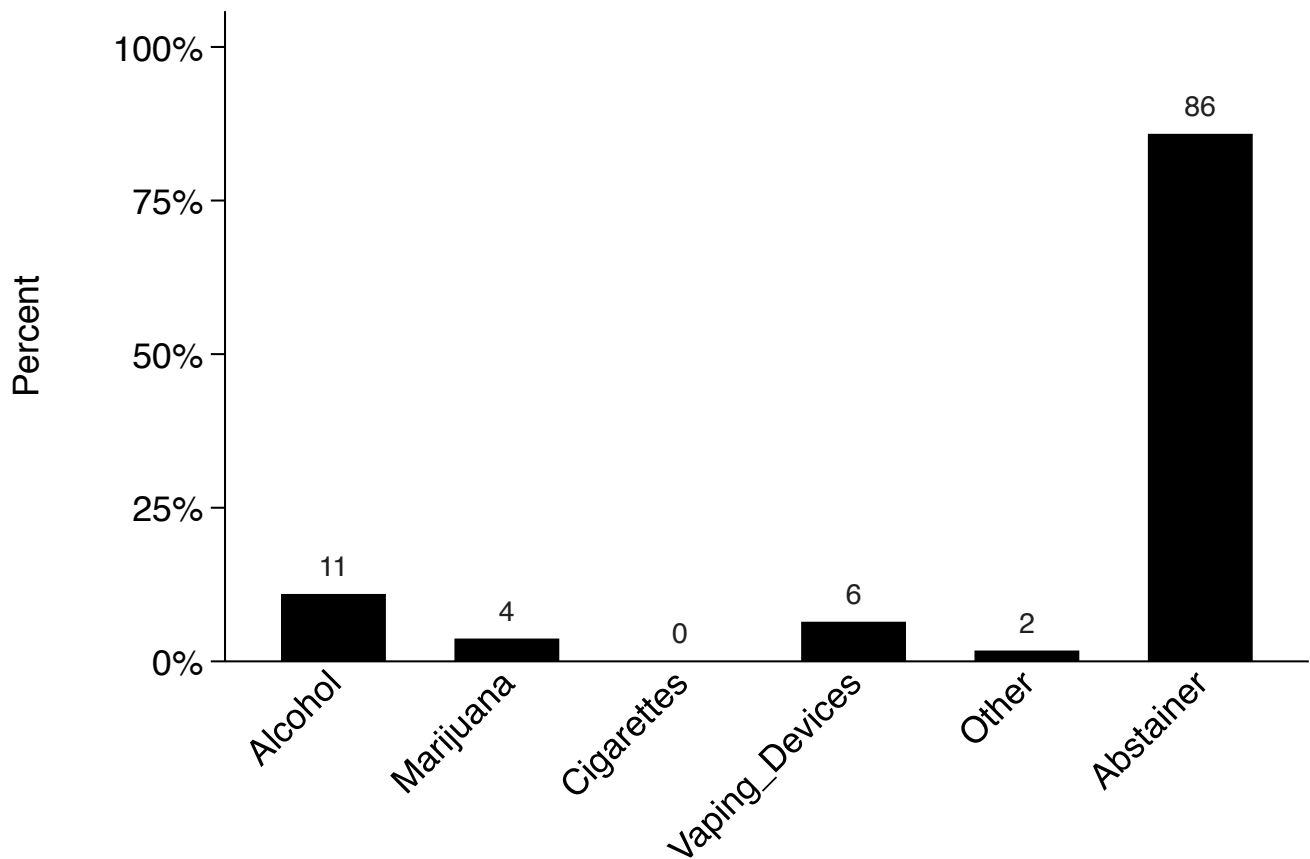
Ethnicity Distribution

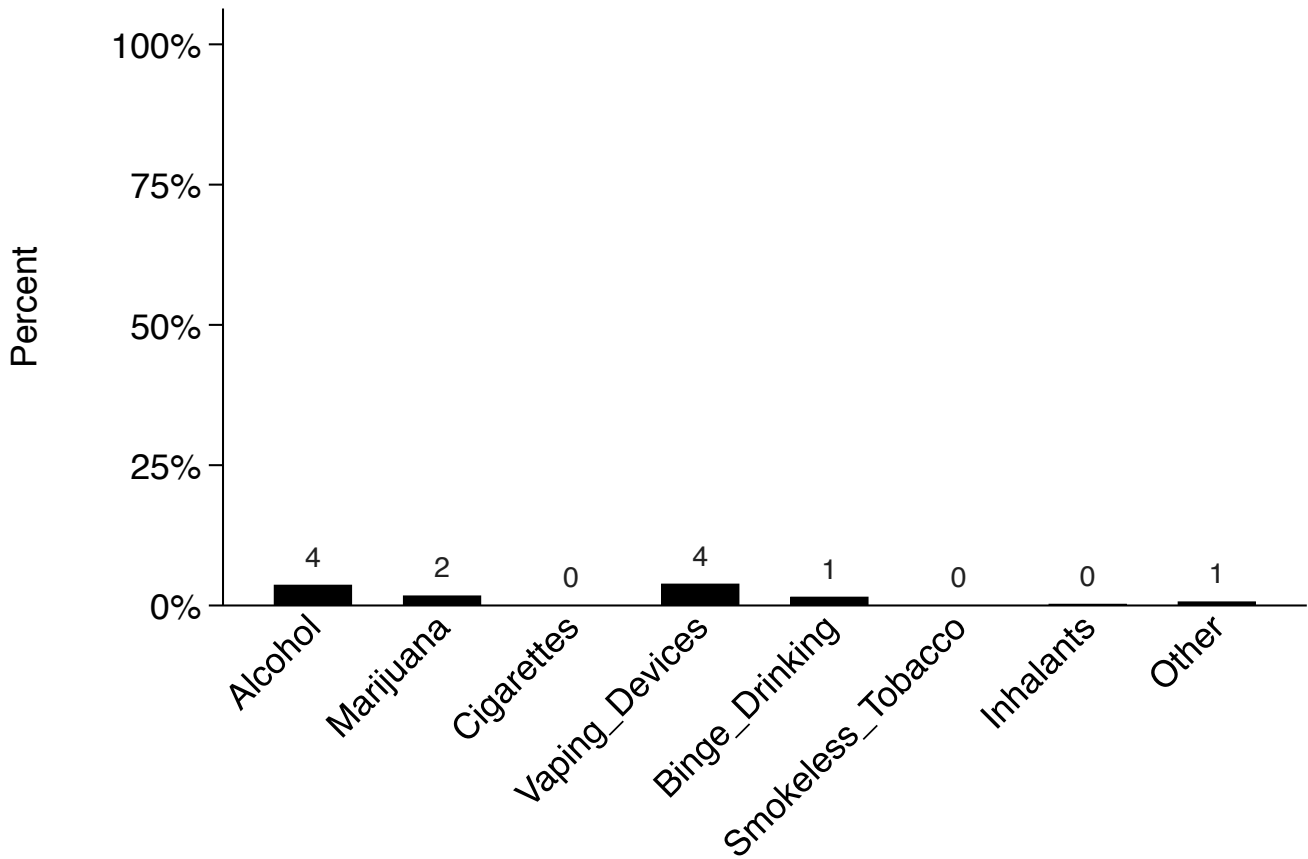

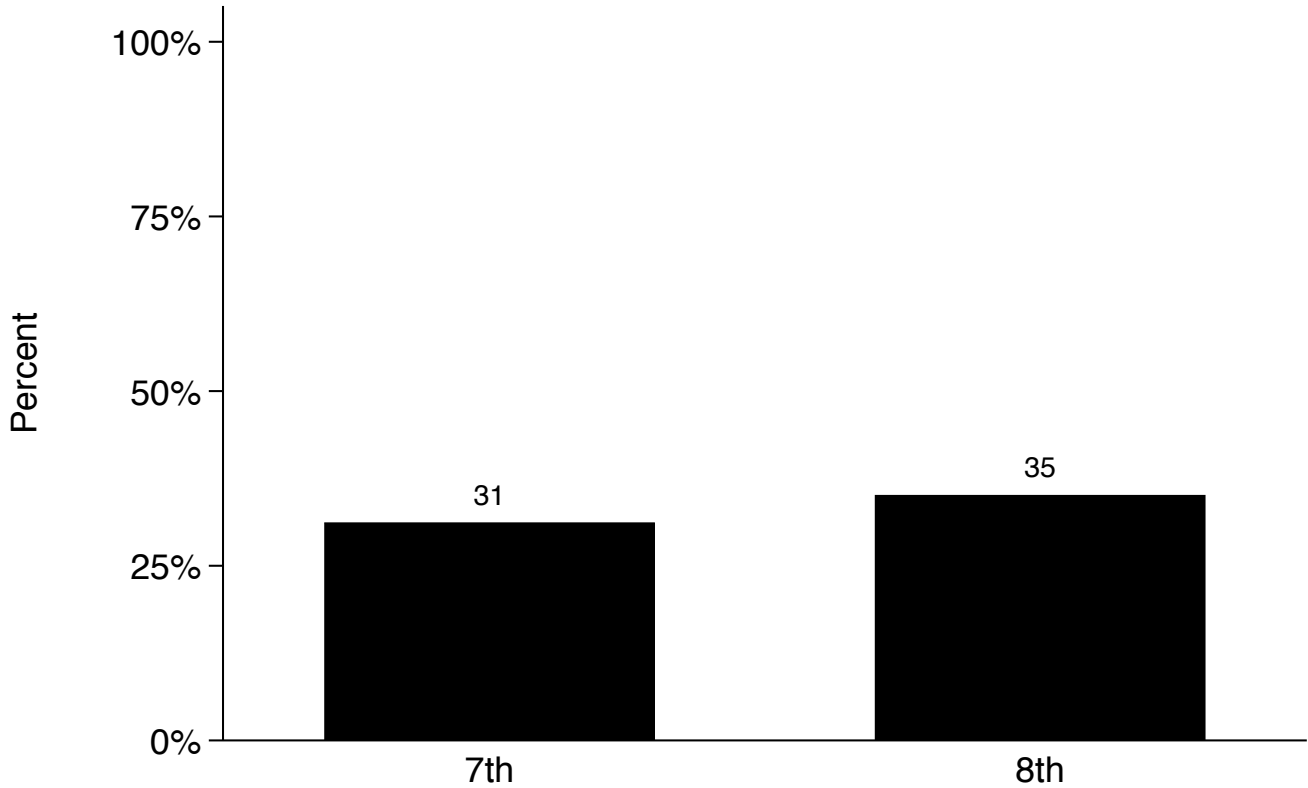
Past Month Substance Use

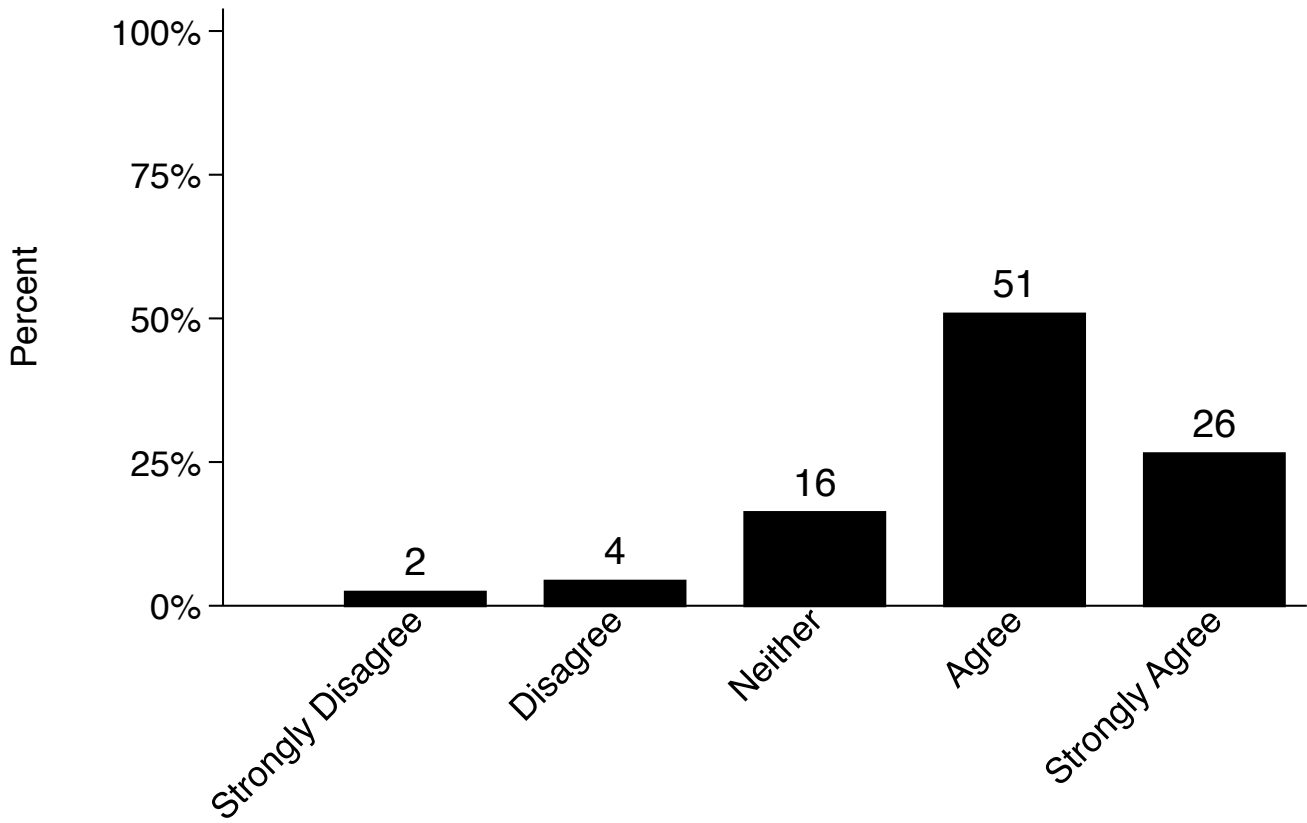
Lifetime Riding in a Car With Someone Driving Drunk

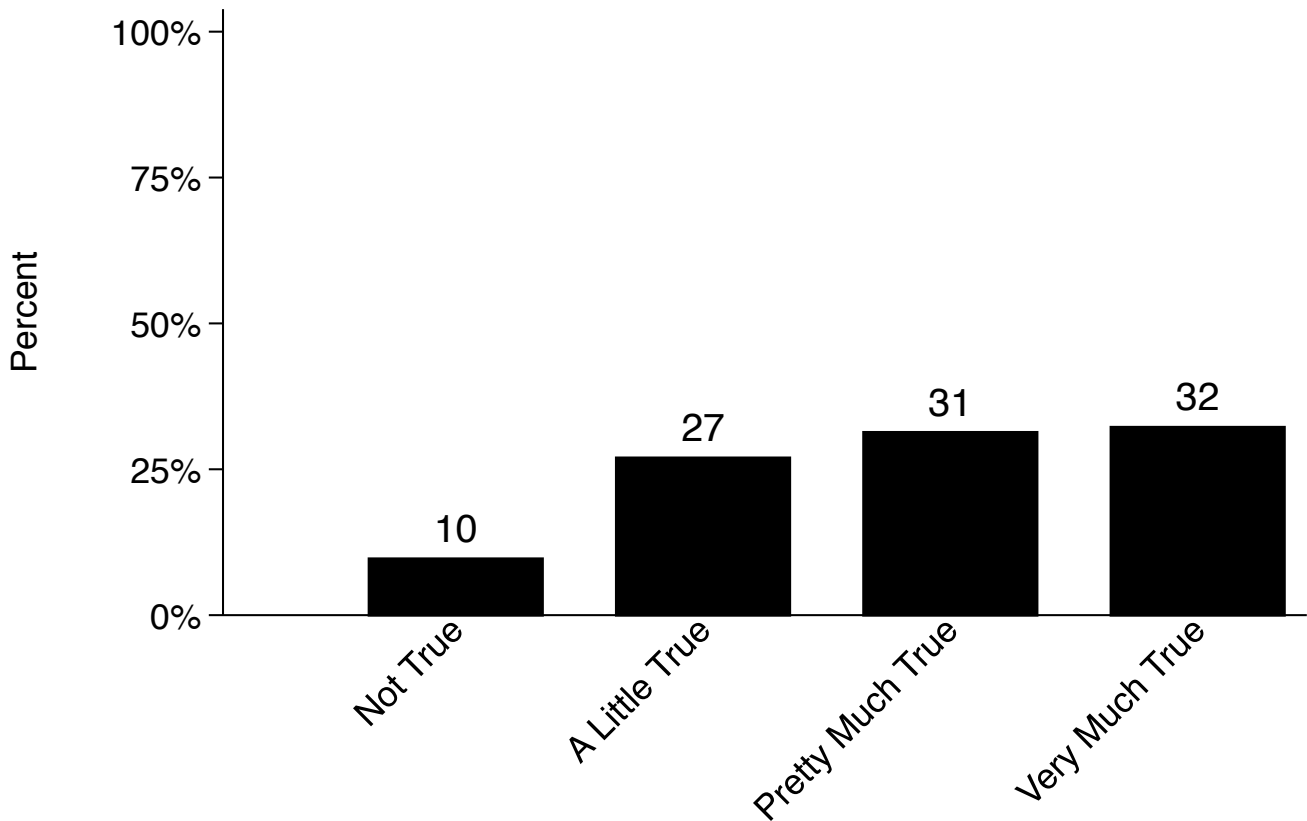

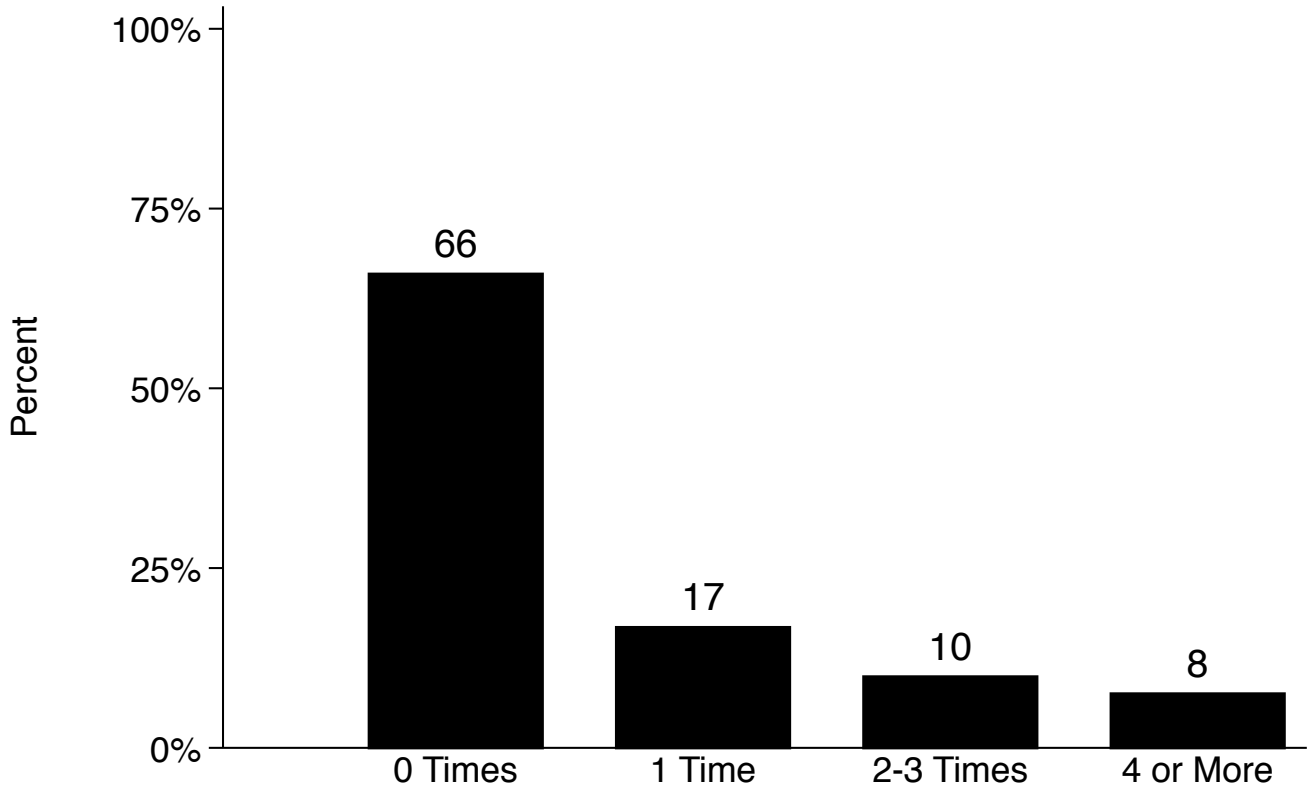
A Teacher or Other Adult Cares About Me

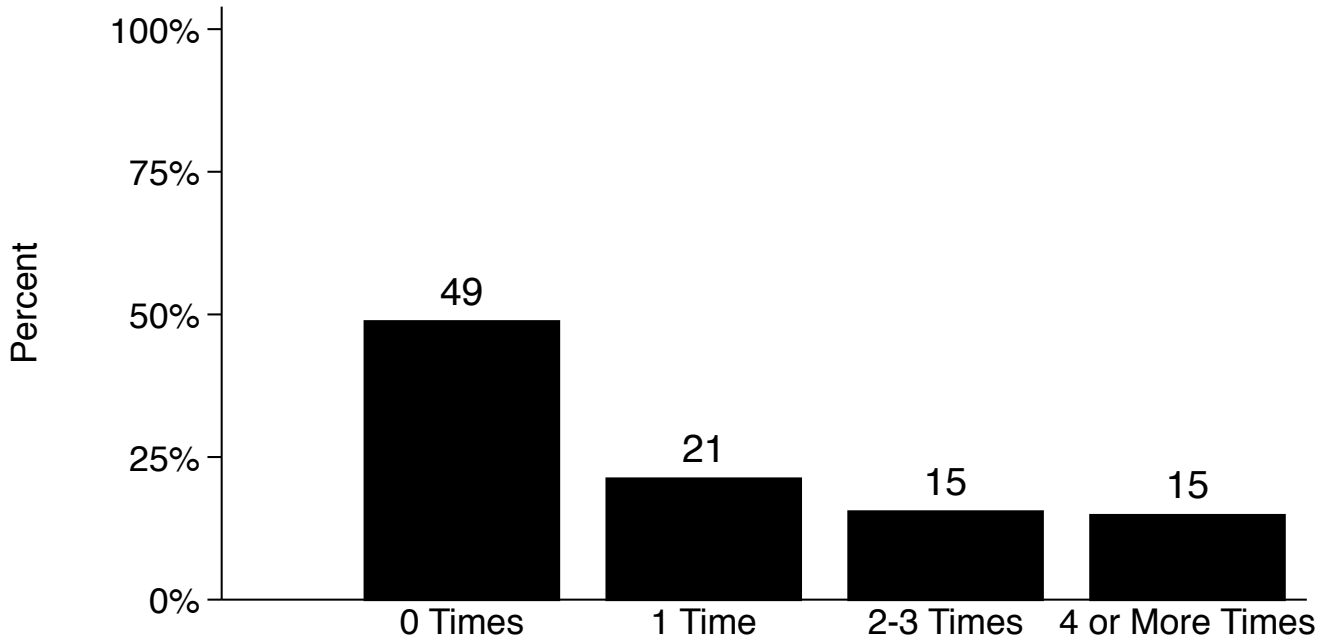
Number of Times You Have Had Mean Rumors Spread About You

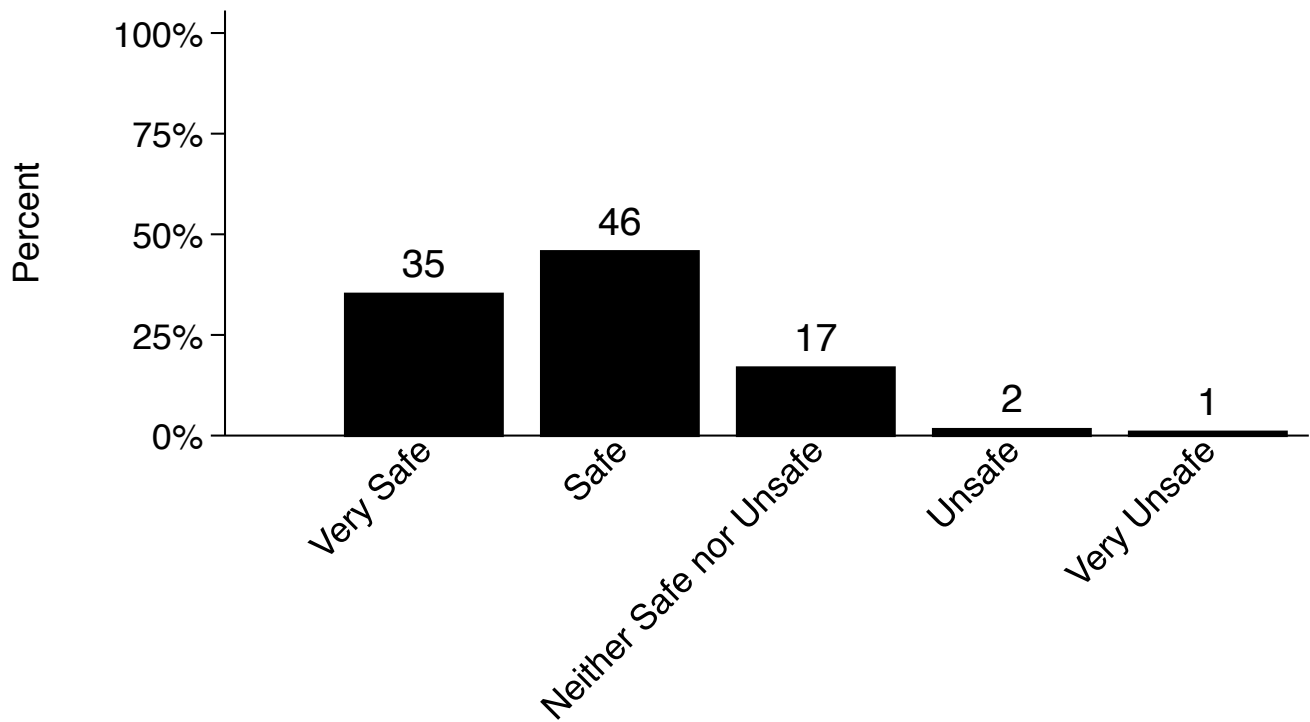
Number of Times Other Students Spread Mean Rumors About You on the Internet for Students Experiencing any Type of Rumors

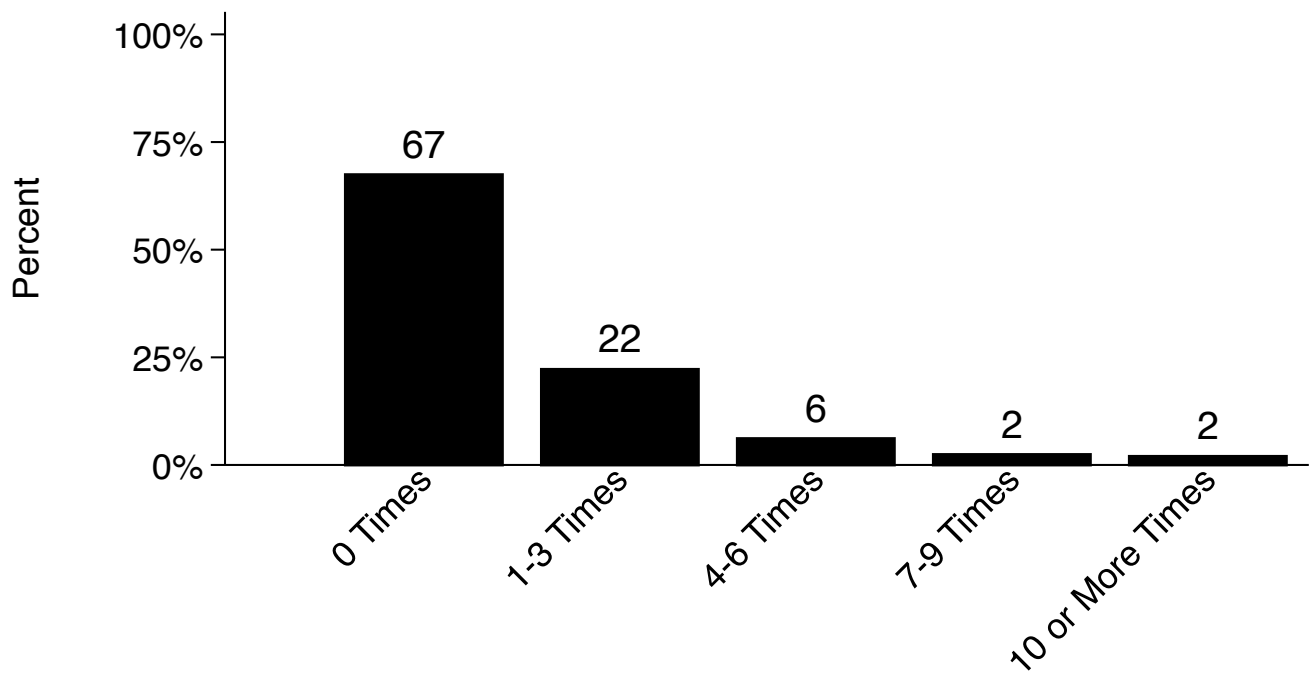
How Safe You Feel When You Are at School

Number of Times You Have Been Bullied in the Last 12 Months

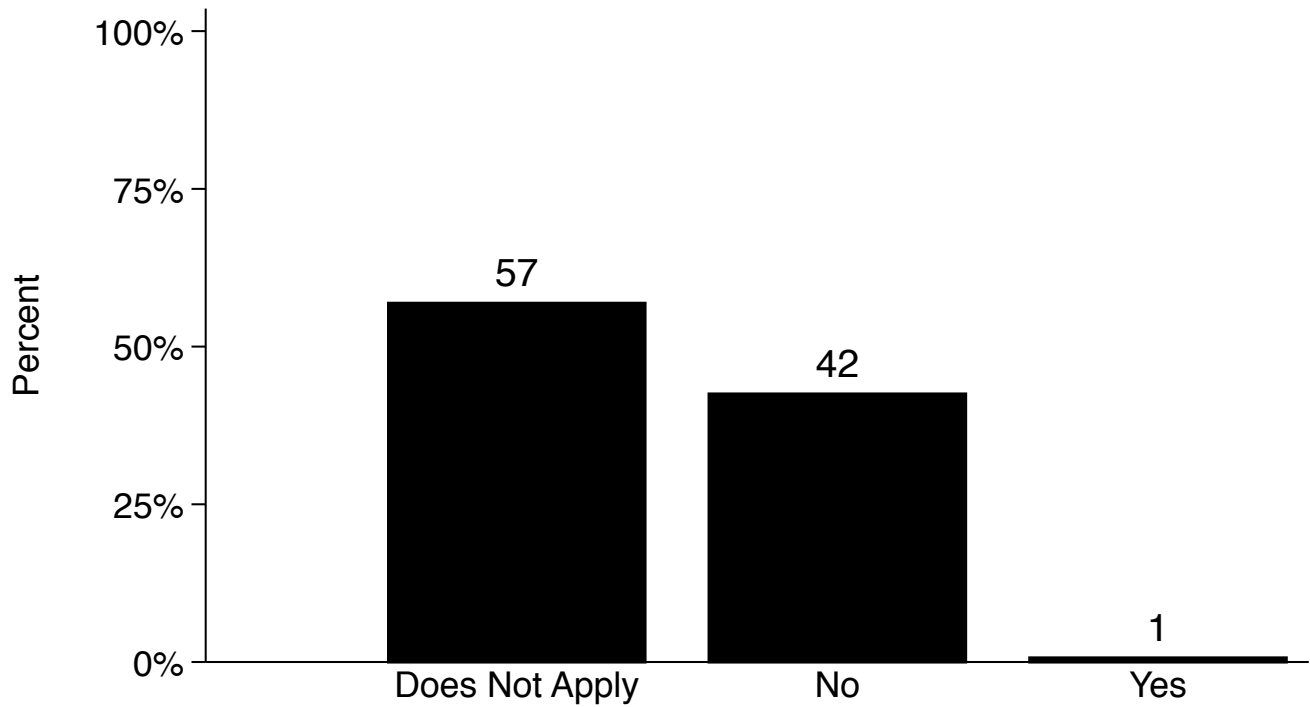

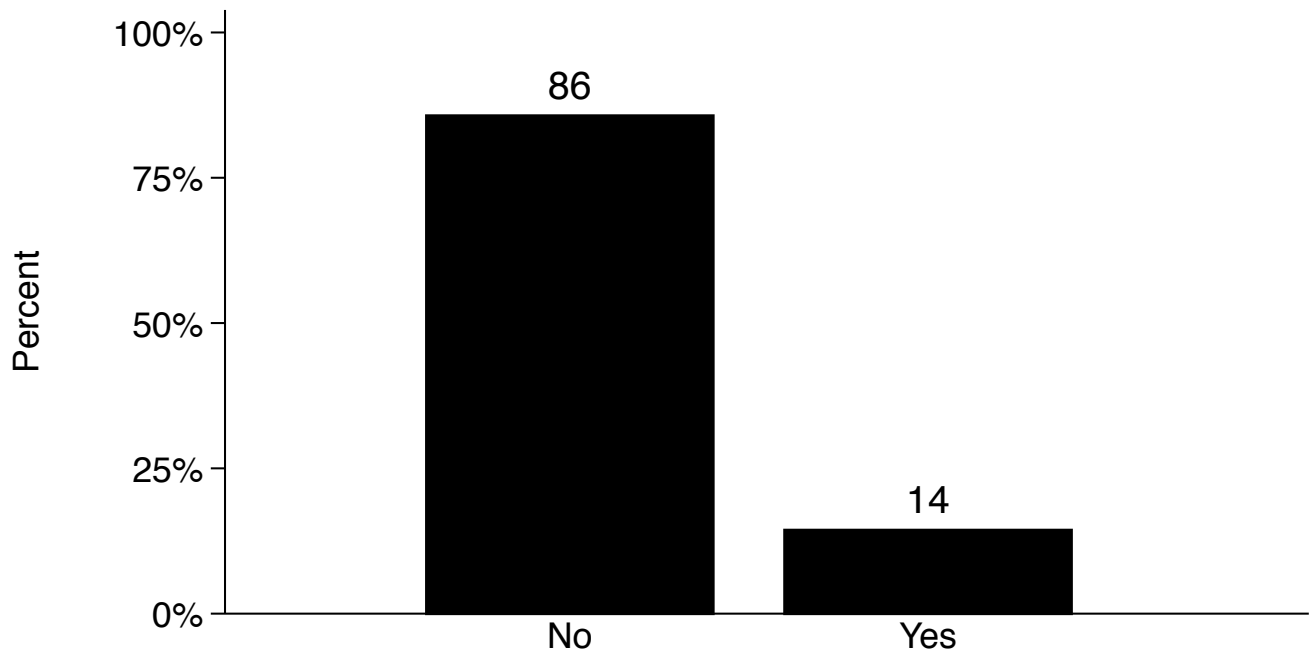

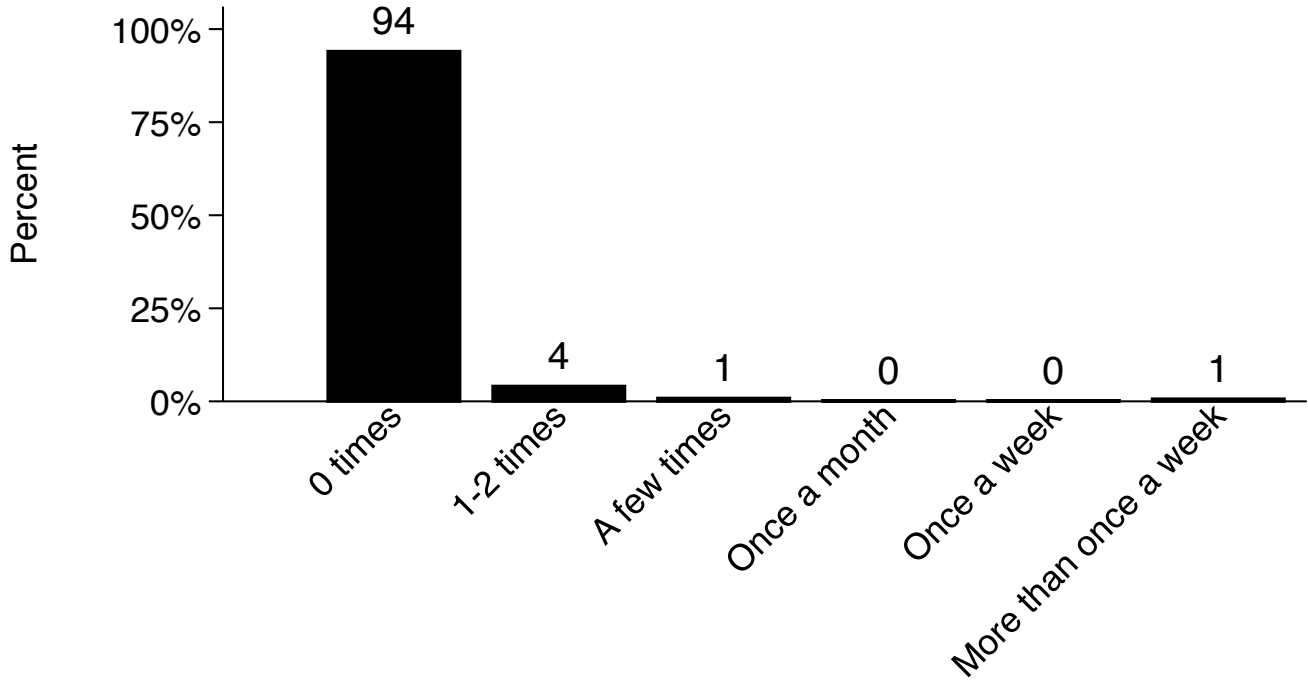

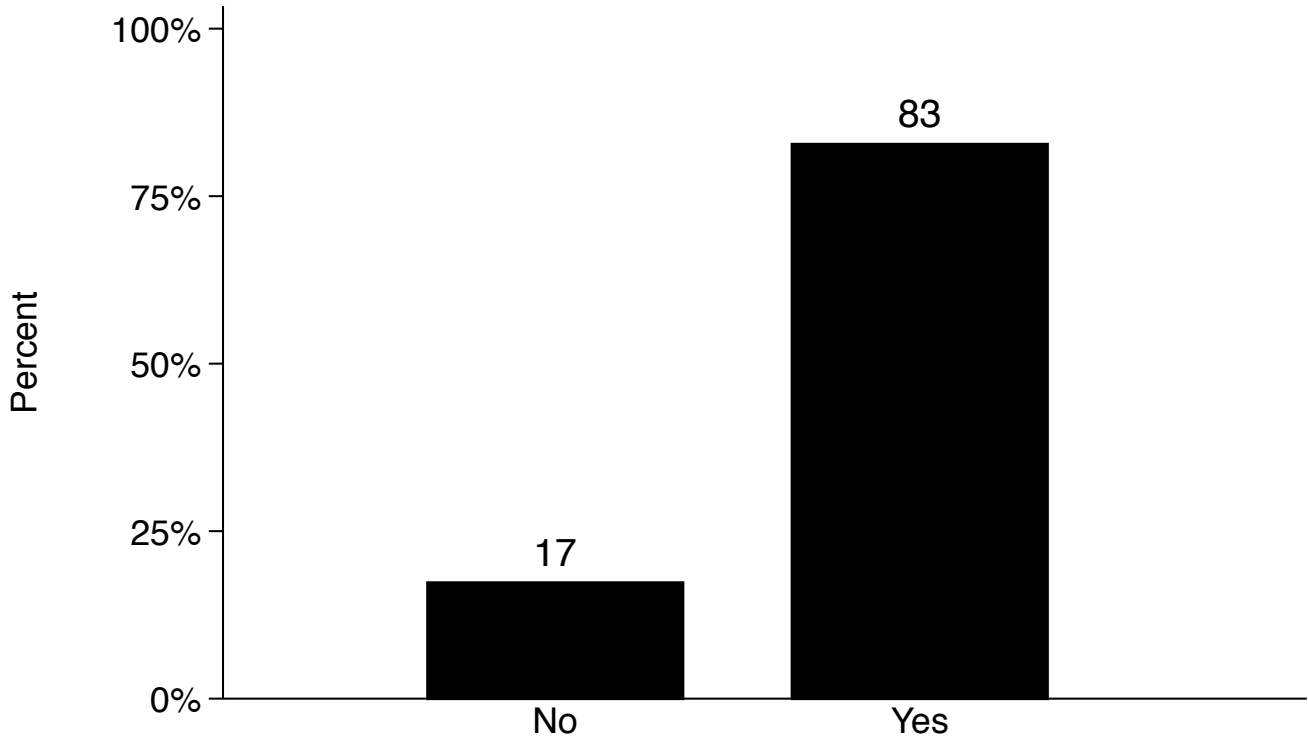

Past Month Substance Use: other drugs includes methamphetamine or any amphetamine, inhalants, LSD or other psychedelics, ecstasy, cocaine, prescription pain medication to get "high" or for reasons other than prescribed (such as Vicodin™, OxyContin™, Percodan™, Ritalin™, Adderall™, Xanax™) and any other drug or pill to get "high".
