EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

On September 16, 2021 the Governor Signed Assembly Bill 361, which amended Government Code Section 54953 of the Brown Act, to authorize local legislative bodies to utilize teleconferencing to conduct Independent Citizens Oversight Committee (ICOC) meetings without complying with certain provisions of the Brown Act set forth in Government Code section 54953(b)(3).

On October 12, 2021 The ICOC approved a resolution authorizing teleconference meetings pursuant to Assembly Bill 361.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the ICOC consider the resolution continuing to authorize teleconference meetings of the San Dieguito Union High School District's ICOC pursuant to Assembly Bill 361 Government Code section 54953.

WHEREAS, on October 12, 2021, the Independent Citizens Oversight Committee approved a Resolution Authorizing Teleconference Meetings of the Independent Citizens Oversight Committee of the San Dieguito Union High School District Pursuant to Assembly Bill 361 (Government Code Section 54953);

WHEREAS, the Committee is required, at least every 30 days, to make certain findings by majority vote to continue conducting its meetings pursuant to Assembly Bill 361 (Government Code Section 54953);

WHEREAS, the March 4, 2020 gubernatorial proclaimed State of Emergency due to COVID-19 remains in place;

WHEREAS, in an effort to reduce the spread of COVID-19 and protect members of the public, the Independent Citizens Oversight Committee desires to continue to implement the provisions of Assembly Bill 361 (Government Code Section 54953) to allow for the use of teleconference (virtual) meetings as authorized under the law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

The Committee has reconsidered the circumstances of the State of Emergency and has determined the following:

1. As a result of the State of Emergency that exists in California due to the COVID-19 pandemic, holding meetings in person would present imminent risks to the health or safety of attendees of the District's Committee meetings.
2. All meetings conducted by the Committee during the operative time period of this Resolution shall be conducted via teleconference (virtual and remote) and shall be conducted in compliance with the requirements set forth in Government Code section 54953(e).
3. The Associate Superintendent of Business Services is hereby authorized and directed to take all actions necessary to carry out the intent and purpose of this Resolution, including ensuring that all meetings of the Committee are conducted in compliance with Government Code section 54953(e) and other applicable provisions of the Brown Act. All meetings shall be conducted in a manner that protects the statutory and constitutional rights of the parties and the public appearing before the Committee.

4. This Resolution shall be effective February 15, 2022, and shall remain in effect for thirty (30) days. The Committee may extend the time period of this Resolution upon reconsideration of the circumstances of the State of Emergency as required by Government Code section 54953(e)(3).
