PUBLIC ACTIVITIES INVOLVING STAFF, STUDENTS OR SCHOOL FACILITIES

BUSINESS ON SCHOOL PROPERTY

No school employee shall distribute or permit distribution of communications of non-school matters without first obtaining the principal's permission.

Unless authorized by the Superintendent, no school employee shall permit the subscription or collection of money on school premises, or allow any article to be exhibited thereon for the purpose of sale or otherwise.

No person shall enter a school for the purpose of photographing pupils, securing names of pupils, or transacting private business, unless specifically authorized to do so by the Superintendent.

The making of special appeals in the classroom for charitable relief shall be permitted at the discretion of the Superintendent and in accordance with Board policy.
