## RELATIONS BETWEEN AREA, STATE, REGIONAL AND NATIONAL ASSOCIATIONS AND SCHOOLS

Membership in recognized associations may be maintained by the schools for several reasons, including:

- 1. The in-service education benefits to our staff and Board which come from participating in meetings, conferences, clinics, and conventions.
- 2. Access to the communication media of such associations, such as newsletters, periodicals, and advisory services.
- 3. Representation in actions affecting education in general and our school district in particular.

The Board in maintaining such membership in no way abdicates its authority over and responsibility for the schools of the district as outlined in State law and Board policy.

The Superintendent of Schools is directed to budget funds for such memberships, and for paying the costs of adequate participation of Board, administration and staff in the activities of such associations to achieve the purposes listed above, as authorized by Board action.
