

**CONTRACTS - STATE ALLOCATION BOARD****DISABLED VETERAN'S BUSINESS PARTICIPATION**

When a lease-purchase or emergency portable building project of over \$10,000 is funded in whole or in part by state bonds issued on or after November 1990, the district must comply with the disabled veteran's business participation requirements of the California Code of Regulations, Title 2, Section 1865.14. The Director of Purchasing and Warehouse Services shall ensure compliance with these regulations.

Prime bidders for contracts of over \$10,000 under California lease-purchase or emergency portable building laws shall certify to the district that they:

1. Are a disabled veteran's business enterprise, as defined in the California Code of Regulations, Title 2, Section 1865.12.5,
2. Will perform 3% of the dollar amount of the contract with a disabled veteran's business enterprise subcontractor or,
3. Have made good faith effort, as described in the California Code of Regulations, Title 2, Section 1865.17, to comply with state regulations governing disabled veteran's business participation in such contracts.

**NOTIFICATION**

To ensure fair and equal dissemination of information regarding disabled veteran's business participation goals to all prospective bidders, specifications for lease-purchase or emergency portable building project contracts let for competitive bidding shall contain the following paragraph:

This contract is subject to the disabled veteran's business enterprise participation goals set forth in California Public Contract Code 10115-10115.10 and State Allocation Board regulations set forth in the California Code of Regulations, Title 2, Sections 1865.12-1865.20 and 1862.51.1-1862.51.2.
