

ENERGY AND WATER MANAGEMENT

District and site plans to conserve resources shall address energy use, water use, and storm water pollution prevention in all operations, including:

1. Educational programs for employees and students.
2. Classroom and building management and maintenance.
3. Food services and equipment maintenance.
4. Landscaping selection and irrigation.
5. Transportation services and maintenance.
6. New and post construction projects.
7. Administrative operations.
8. Use of facilities by outside groups.
9. Reduced energy use or shutting down of facilities during vacation periods.

The plan shall establish specific goals for each school and for other district facilities.

To enlist the support which is essential to the success of the resources management plan, principals and supervisors shall:

1. Solicit comments related to the management plan.
2. Expect students and staff to cooperate in all energy and water management efforts.
3. Give recognition to those who achieve outstanding conservation results.
4. Comply with all requirements of the storm water pollution prevention plan.
