PROFESSIONAL GROWTH REQUIREMENTS

Teachers who were issued their first clear teaching credentials after August 31, 1985 shall be responsible for working with a district professional growth advisor to develop an individual professional growth program consisting of a minimum of 150 clock hours.

- A. Professional Growth Advisors
 - 1. All District principals and District office administrators are listed as professional growth advisors with the exception of the superintendent and the Director of Personnel Services.
 - 2. Teachers may select an advisor of their choice from a list of district professional growth advisors.
 - 3. The list of professional growth advisors shall contain the names of advisors as well as their areas of certification.
- B. Resolution of Disputes Between Teachers and Advisors
 - 1. The Director of Personnel Services shall serve as the mediator and/or appeal agent to expedite resolution of disputes between teachers and advisors.
 - 2. A teacher or an advisor may submit a letter to the Director of Personnel Services requesting assistance in resolving a dispute.
