

DSPS: Getting Started

- 1. Call DSPS to schedule intake appointment with DSPS Counselor. Phone: (760)795-6658
- 2. Bring disability verification to intake appointment.
 - IEP, 504 Plan, Psycho-educational report, medical documentation, Regional Center Report, etc.
- 3. During intake:
 - Interactive process with DSPS Counselor
 - Review disability verification
 - Create Academic Accommodation Plan (AAP)
 - Receive Accommodation Letters to give instructors
- 4. Return to DSPS every semester for Accommodation Letters.



Learning Disabilities

 If your IEP states "Specific Learning Disability", please submit your IEP <u>AND</u> Psycho-Educational Report with testing scores to DSPS.

 If you suspect you have a Learning Disability (LD) and have never been tested, MiraCosta College offers LD Testing through the DSPS office.



What happens to my IEP?

- MiraCosta College DSPS accepts IEPs as verification of disability.
- IEP process ends when student exits/graduates from high school.
- Student will not have an IEP team at MiraCosta College.
- Disability status is kept confidential.
