

Connecting an Android Phone or Tablet

1. Open the Wi-Fi settings on your phone or tablet.

Different Android devices have different ways to get to these settings. Check the website for your phone if you need to find how to open the settings.

Tap “SDUHSD” to sign in.



2. Set “EAP method” to “PEAP”
Set “Phase 2 authentication” to “MSCHAPV2”
Set “CA certificate” to “Do not validate”
Under “Identity”, enter your district username:


Staff: **firstname.lastname**

Students:
last name + first initial + last 4 digits of permanent ID

Leave “Anonymous identity” blank.

Under “Password”, enter the password you use to login to district computers.

Tap “Save” to connect.



3. After a few seconds, you will see “Connected” show up underneath the SDUHSD network. In the future, your device will connect to the network automatically.

If your device cannot connect to SDUHSD, try the same steps to connect to “guest-SDUHSD”. If you can only connect to the guest network, you will have to enter your name and password each time you log in.
